In the case you describe, the process is to submit a correction request to the organization if you believe the fact-checker reached an incorrect conclusion. If you have evidence that the organization has seriously breached the code, then you can file a complaint to IFCN using the right channel so that an independent assessor can review it. It looks like there's a misunderstanding about where the network comes in. That part is described in the complaints policy section.
